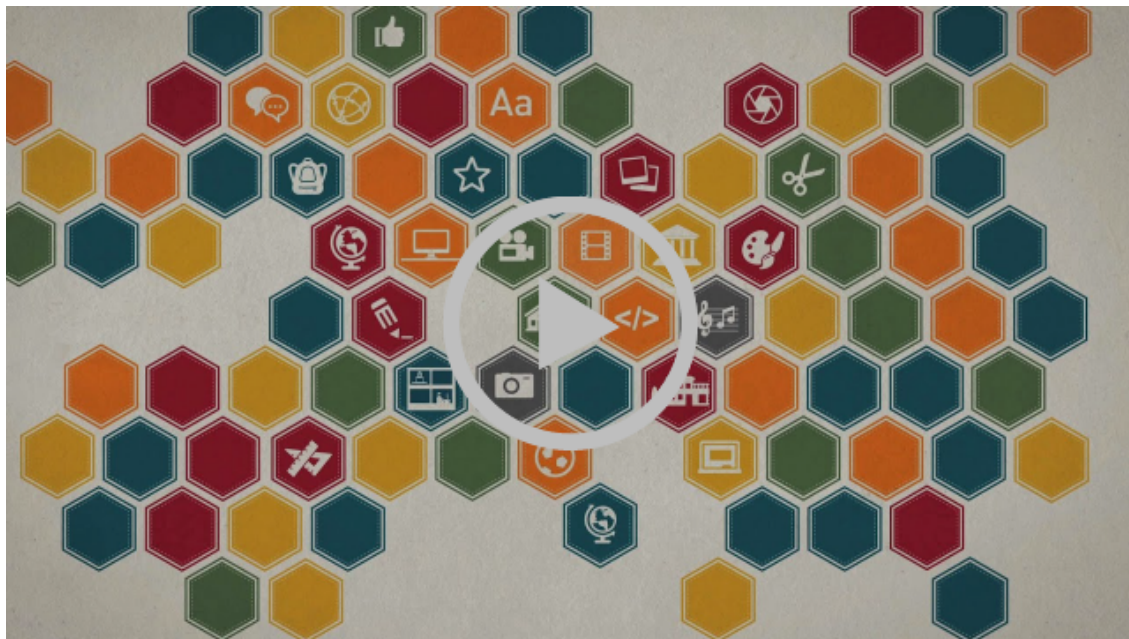

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Participates synchronous or asynchronously in FCI-sponsored event or programming.</li> <li>Submits reflection on how the knowledge gained could affect his/her teaching, service, or scholarship.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Takes the next step; apply knowledge gained to change some aspect of their teaching.</li> <li>Submits evidence with artifacts demonstrating a change in practice (revised assignment, new grading rubric, etc.)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Learns &amp; implements a topic to the extent that she/he can influence the learning of others inside or outside of the Park community.</li> <li>Qualifying venues for knowledge sharing include all FCI sponsored events.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>One-time badge based on a specific achievement or completion of intensive work.</li> <li>Highlights honors/awards/certifications through FCI.</li> <li>Requires a claim code to access all achievement badges.</li> </ul>
