Program Overview:

As a Fellow, you will get to:

- Participate in a 2-day Faculty Fellows Retreat (May 2020).
- Meet with Faculty Fellows to collaborate, provide feedback on teaching projects and brainstorm together.
- Host a SIG (special interest group*) on the topic of your choosing – minimum of 4 meetings during academic year.
- Conduct one 15-minute “Innovation Exchange” presentation and create a “2-minute mentor” module.

*A special interest group is a group of people who have similar interests/goals/topics related to teaching or the scholarship of teaching. Topics might include: interdisciplinary & team teaching, teaching today's learners, building a positive faculty culture, faculty book club, teaching with technology, or other topics of interest.
