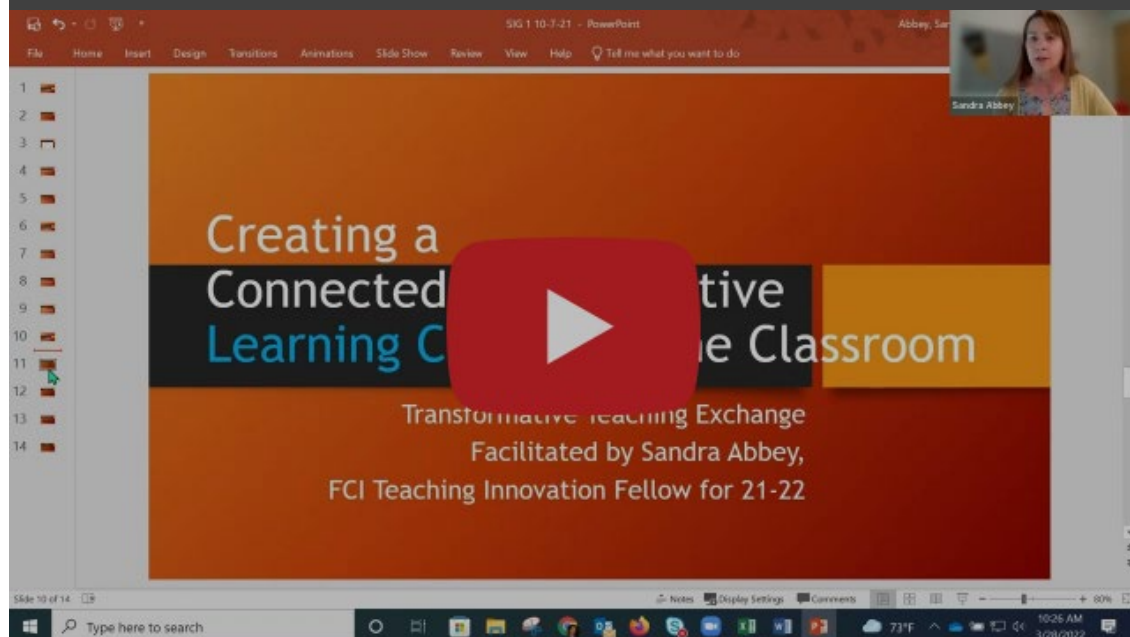
2022 FELLOWS SHARE OUT


